LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE – SUMMARY OF DECISIONS

Licensing Sub-Committee – Thursday 21 May 2015 10.00am

The Piccadilly London Soho, 69 Shaftesbury Avenue, W1 (West End Ward / West End Stress Area) – An application for a new premises licence, involving non-hotel residents, for late night refreshment from 23:00 to 01:30 Monday to Sunday and the sale by retail of alcohol Monday to Sunday 10:00 to 01:00. The exhibition of films had also been applied for twenty four hours a day which was largely restricted to hotel residents' bedrooms. The hotel currently had a premises licence for licensable activities for non-hotel residents. Late night refreshment was permitted until 23:30 Monday to Saturday and the sale of alcohol until 23:00 Monday to Saturday and 22:30 on Sunday.

The Applicant intended to move the restaurant from the basement to the ground floor and had agreed a proposed condition by Environmental Health that after 18:00 hours this area would operate as a restaurant with alcohol being ancillary to substantial table meals. The Applicant however was seeking as part of the proposed conditions to have pre-booked functions in the basement function room where alcohol would not be ancillary to food. The Sub-Committee was concerned that this could take place until 01:00 and following a discussion on this point, the Applicant amended the timing for the sale of alcohol in the area until Core Hours (23:30 Monday to Thursday, midnight Friday to Saturday and 22:30 on Sunday). The Applicant also advised that there would be SIA door staff at the concierge and reception at all hours and the entrance to the restaurant would be closed after 22:00 which the SIA was able to supervise as the concierge was in close proximity. The Sub-Committee granted the application, including the amended hours for the pre-booked functions in the basement function room. Members added a condition that alcohol between 10:00 and midday on Sundays would be ancillary to a table meal.

Karaoke Box, 12-14 Maddox Street, W1 (West End Ward / West End Stress Area) – the premises operates as a bar with karaoke facilities. The existing premises licence permits a terminal hour of 02:00 for licensable activities except for the sale of alcohol where a terminal hour of 01:00 is permitted. The Applicant sought to vary the premises licence so that there was an extension of hours for licensable activities on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays to 04:30 save for alcohol to 04:00. The intended closing time was 05:00. There would be a reduction of hours on the other evenings for licensable activities. The Sub-Committee took the view that the application was in the stress area and that the policy on music and dancing applied. The Applicant had put forward the case that there was an exception to the policy for this application as it was entertainment led. Members considered that whilst there was an entertainment aspect to the application it was not sufficient grounds in itself to warrant an exception to policy. There would be up to 55 people potentially remaining in the premises for several hours and

patrons would leave the premises and enter the West End Stress Area at a later hour on significant nights of the week. The application was refused.

Les Deux Salons, 40-42 William IV Street, WC2 (St James's Ward / West End Stress Area) – An application to vary the premises licence. The original application had included the proposed extension of hours for licensable activities. However the Applicant's Representative advised that this aspect of the application had now been withdrawn. He stated that his client had become aware of noise issues only recently as raised by local residents. It had been agreed that there would be an independent noise survey of the premises. Two local residents explained their concerns regarding noise from Les Deux Salons, including being adversely affected when furniture or rubbish was moved.

The remaining aspects of the application were to vary the layout of the premises and remove conditions on the licence. Environmental Health and Metropolitan Police were content with the proposals with the former agreeing a capacity of 120 on the ground floor and 110 on the first floor with the Applicant and the Metropolitan Police commenting that a reduction in the numbers standing and drinking at the bar in the stress area as a result of more seating being provided was welcomed (the aim was for it to become more like a café/bistro). One aspect raised by one of the residents was a concern that a table and chairs on the ground floor were sticking outside the concertina doors. The Applicant's Representative advised that these were within the demise of the premises. The Sub-Committee granted the revised application with all windows and doors being closed by 21:00 hours.

Toast, 11 South Molton Street, W1 (West End Ward / not in stress area) – The Applicant's Representative advised that he had agreed to amend both the sale of alcohol and opening hours to Core Hours. Following a request by a local resident at the hearing, he also agreed to remove the requirement for takeaway sales of alcohol. All off sales would be consumed at the outside tables and chairs and both off sales and on sales would be ancillary to a table meal. The Sub-Committee had received a number of written representations from residents and heard from the local resident at the meeting about the residential nature of South Molton Street and that it was relatively quiet early in the evening. Members therefore decided that the outside tables and chairs would be rendered unusable at 19:00 each day which was consistent with the planning restrictions on their use. The Sub-Committee granted on sales to Core Hours as requested by the Applicant in the revised application.
